This Indenture made this sixteenth day of February in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and twenty, between William Andrus of the State of Georgia and County of Wilkes, of the one part & Joseph Pullen Junr of the same State and County of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Andrus for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred & Eighteen Dollars to one in hand paid by the said Joseph Pullen Junr, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold & by these presents do bargain sell and confirm unto the said Joseph Pullen Junr his heirs and assigns forever all my distributive part of a tract of Land on the Waters of Pistol Creek in the County aforesaid containing two hundred & seven acres more or less it being the tract of Land ~~whereby~~ whereon Elijah Lindsay deceased formerly lived and do warrant & defend the same from all persons unto the said Joseph Pullen Junr his heirs & assigns forever.
