Clermont County. Be it remembered that on  
the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June One thousand  
eight hundred and eighteen Came  
personally before me Alex<sup>r</sup> Blair a  
Judge of the Court of Common Pleas and for  
said County Ezekiah Searcy aged Seventy  
one years and being duly sworn on the Holy  
Evangelists deposeth and saith he enlisted in the  
army of the United States in the County of West-  
moreland and State of Pennsylvania in the Comp-  
any commanded by Captain Uriah Springer  
in the Regiment commanded by Colonel  
John Gibson in the Virginia Line in Continental  
Establishment that he served in the American Army  
three years the full time he had enlisted for &  
that he obtained his discharge from the Army  
at Fort Pitt now Pittsburgh Pa that some  
years after the War he transmitted his said  
discharge to the State of Virginia to obtain his  
land Warrant. but that he never obtained  
any land for his services. the deponent offers the  
annexed deposition of Amos Chalmers as evidence  
that he never has obtained any Pension and hereby  
relinquishes every pension heretofore allowed by the

Laws of the United States - And this deponent  
the said Hezekiah Lindsey on his oath aforesaid  
declares that from his several circumstances  
he needs the assistance of his Country for support

On the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1818  
Alex<sup>r</sup> Blair - came personally before me  
a Judge of the Court of Common  
Pleas within and for said County Andrew Chalmers  
and being duly sworn according to Law deposeth and  
sath that he saw the above named Hezekiah Lindsey  
at Fort Pitt in the State of Pennsylvania in the year

one thousand seven hundred and eighty that he  
<sup>having obtained a pardon</sup>  
travell'd with him while both of them were on their  
way home about 40 miles that he this deponent uncer-  
tain and does verily believe believe that the said  
Hezekiah had served in the American Army of the  
revolution against the Common Enemy

Andrew Chalmers  
testify that <sup>the</sup> above named Hezekiah Lindsey took  
and subscribed before me the above oath and that it  
appears to my satisfaction that he served in the Revolutionary  
War against the Common and also that <sup>the</sup> above named  
Andrew Chalmers took and before the above oath subscribed  
Alex<sup>r</sup> Blair
