and in consideration of the Sum of Fifty Dollars
to them in hand paid the receipt whereof they
do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained
sold aliened conveyed & confirmed and by their
Privates Do grant bargain sell alien convey
and confirm unto the said George Huchelberg
his heirs and assigns forever a certain lot in
the Town of Springfield to witt by the Name
thirty four with the appurtenances thereto
belonging to have and to hold the said Lot
with its appurtenances unto the said George
his heirs and assigns in the only proper and
benefit and behoof of him the said George
Huchelberg his heirs & assigns forever unto the
said Sundry and Betsey his Wife as
in the warrant and well known copies the
said Lot of Land and appurtenances unto the
said George Huchelberg his heirs and assigns
forever against the Claim or Claims of all

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and every person or persons whatsoever lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same
